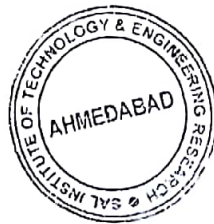

2. Your willingness to conduct the program.

Sanction is hereby accorded to conduct ISTE approved and GTU sponsored Faculty Development Program on **Advancement in Civil Engineering** during **07-01-2019 to 11-01-2019**.

You are requested to take steps to conduct the program subject to the following terms and conditions (as laid down by the GTU):

1. The total budget sanctioned for the program is Rs.1,00,000/-. The additional expenses over the budget limit of Rs.1,00,000/- shall be borne by the host institution if any. The host institute may get the sponsorship from other organization to cover the additional expenses. The duration of the program is for one week.
2. If the actual expenses are below the limit of Rs.1,00,000/-, GTU shall provide the financial assistance equal to the actual expenses only (after deducting the amount of Registration Fees & Income from other sources).
3. GTU will not provide any advance amount to host institute. The host institute will submit the original bills along with other required documents to ISTE Gujarat. After verification (having original bills, report of FDP with Photographs, Fund Utilisation Certificate, TDS declaration, Feedback form and Attendance sheet duly signed by participants for all days) ISTE Gujarat will hand over the file of respective host institute to GTU for reimbursement of bills.
4. Please prepare an information brochure on the program containing desired information and salient features of the program inviting applications from all the institutions in your area. Preference should be given to the participants having ISTE Life Membership and those who are not members, kindly ensure and arrange to enroll them as members of ISTE before/during commencement of the program.
5. ISTE will do the certification of these programs jointly with GTU.
6. The coordinator must be a full time regular faculty and must of ISTE Life Member with adequate experience in teaching and research with publication.

7. The fund will be sponsored by GTU and the sanction budget is Rs.1,00,000/- . The host institute may get the sponsorship from other organisations to cover the additional expenses and also from the participants through "Registration Fees". Colleges may charge upto Rs.1000/- per participants for one week FDP as registration fees. Fees received from the participants will be utilized by institutes to conduct the event.
8. GTU will not provide any advance amount to host institute.
9. Minimum 25 participants are required to conduct the FDP and maximum 40 participants can be accommodated in one batch. It is mandatory to invite 60% speakers/subject experts from other institutes/organisations.
10. While making claim, institute will clearly mention income from all sources. Total actual expenses after deducting registration fees and income from other sources will be reimbursed by GTU subject to maximum ceiling of Rs.1,00,000/- e.g.:

Total expenses	: Rs.1,50,000/-
Registration fees & income from other sources	: Rs.60,000/-
Amount to be reimbursed by GTU to host institute	: Rs.90,000/- (Rs.1,50,000 – Rs.60,000)

11. A test should be conducted at the end of the programme and the certificates will be issued only for those participants whose attendance is full and should qualify the test.

- Expenditure details (copy of audited statement of programme signed by practicing Chartered Accountant)
- Selected photographs of programme
- Conclusion.

13. Any change in the schedule for holding the program, change of Coordinator's name, venue and date would require prior approval, failing which the offer for the grant already issued would be treated as automatically withdrawn.
14. Surprise visits will be planned by GTU and ISTE during the Program. They will have discussions with the course coordinator, resource persons and the participants. They will be submitting their report to ISTE which in turn will be submitted to GTU.
15. Eminent personalities in the field must be invited as the resource person and minimum one good resource person from industry should be invited during the program.
16. You are requested to introduce one session on **Art of Living** during the program .
