- **Day 1 (28<sup>th</sup> September, Friday):**

On the very first day, the registration started at sharp 08:30. As a host institute, we welcomed all the team managers & participants heartily at the registration desk and served them delicious breakfast. At sharp 10:30, the inauguration ceremony started on the Open air theatre stage. Initially, Our Hon. Vice-chancellor, Dr. Akshai Aggarwal had consented to remain present in the Inauguration Ceremony, but due to some unavoidable circumstance, he could not attend the inauguration ceremony. The ceremony started with key note address of Hon. Vice-Chancellor through Video conferencing.
