- A quiz competition will be organised in which it is desired that maximum students should participate so that they are sensitized to the contribution of our freedom fighters and also regarding the events as they unfolded during the freedom struggle. Details of the competition will be made available shortly on the UGC website and on <u>www.mygov.in</u>. Students may give answers in online and offline mode.

You are requested to undertake the above activities in your esteemed University and affiliated colleges and publicize them so that general public is made aware. The activities undertaken during this momentous month should be shared in the forms of photographs and reports on a dedicated facebook page of MHRD.
