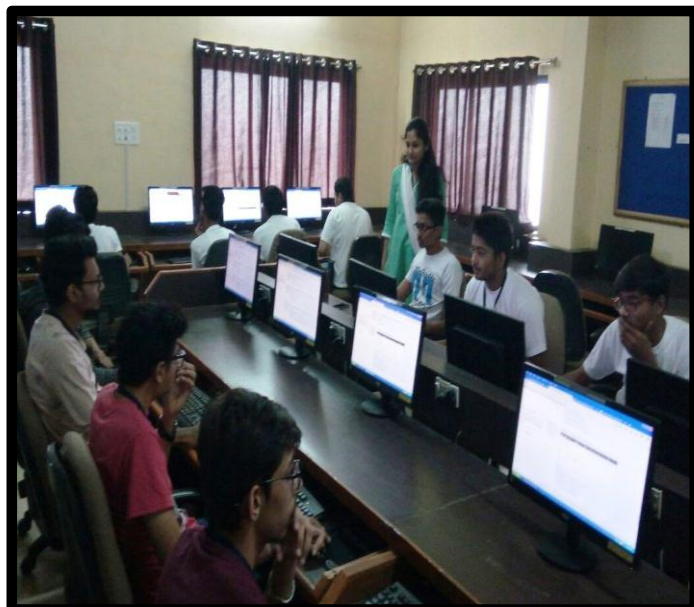
Outcomes:

- Students get Idea about the free Text editor like Gedit Text Editor and aware with its uses.

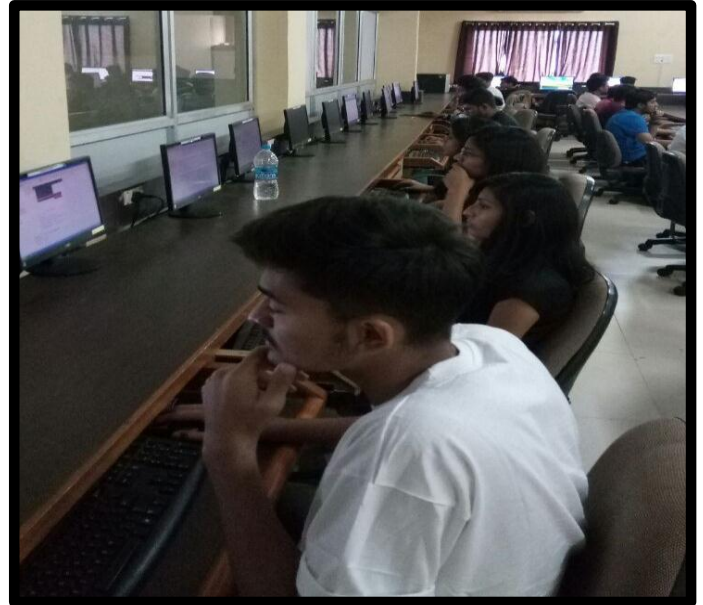

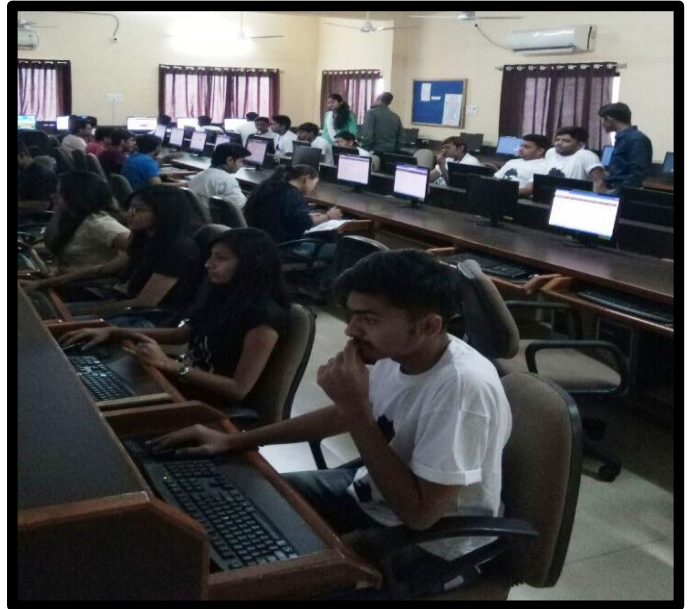

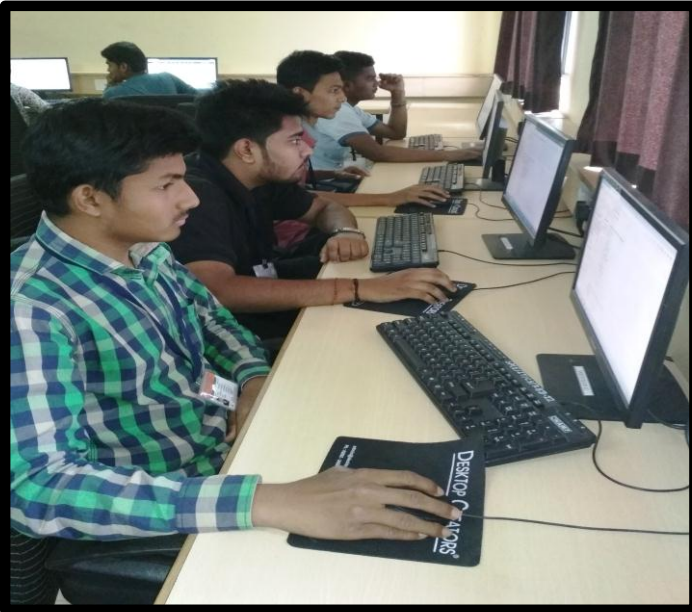

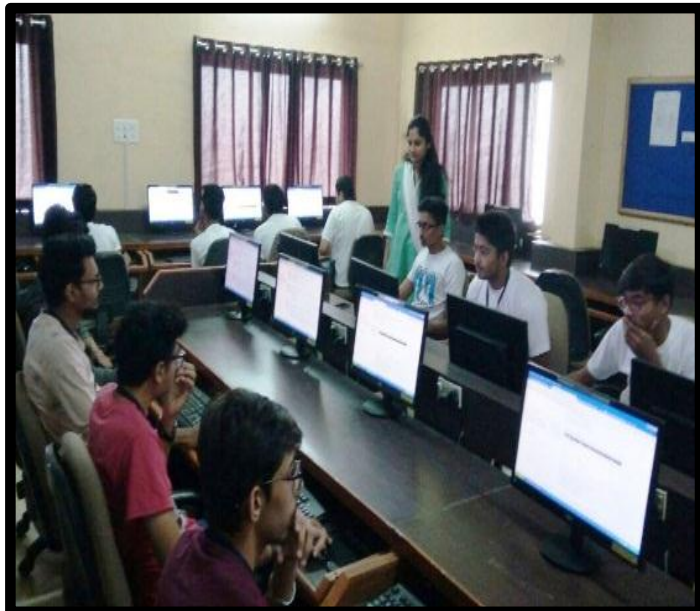
