Introduction:

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Inaugral Session :

Day 1 of training programme started with the **inaugural ceremony. Ms. Rupam Sikligar**, Co-ordinator of Role of Libraries and Librarians in Pandemic Era started the programme with introductory speech and virtual lamp Lightening, Prayer and University Anthem followed by highlights of the programme.

Day wise content of Resource Persons :

Day 1 of the training programme started with the talk by **Dr. Shailesh Yagnik, Adviser MICA MIMI and KEIC**. He explained about the concept of Digital Marketing and its application in Libraries with statistical data. He also aware the participants about how social media platforms/tools can be used for marketing of library products and services. The second talk was delivered by **Mr. Chintan Pandya, Head Librarian**, Anant National University, on Reference Management Tools. He wonderfully explained the need and use of these tools as well as its application in research to save time of the researcher. The talk on Quantification of Research Performance and Productivity was delivered by **Dr. Pradip Patel, Assistant Librarian, Gujarat Vidhyapith**. He focused on the concepts of various metrics and how to measure the performance and productivity of the research as well as how h-index, i10 index, impact factor affects the research. He elaborate on how to evaluate research, bibliometerics, Web of Science as well as SCOPUS.



He focused on categories of IPR, role of oraganizations to protect them, constitutional aspects of IP, categories of IPR, online Registration process as well as copyright and legal issues related to them. The second talk was delivered by **Dr. Dharmendra Trivedi** on Measuring Service Quality in Academic Libraries. He explained about the tools for measurement of quality of services as well as its application in libraries. He elaborated about SERVQUAL, LIBQUAL models and their features. **Mr. Viral Navik,** Assistant Librarian, IIMA delivered the talk on Virtual Reality in Libraries. He described the concept of Virtual Reality (VR) or Augmented Reality (AR) and its structure and



its use in libraries. He also showcased few examples of various services in which VR/AR can be implemented to provide the library services. The fourth talk of the day was delivered by **Dr. Bhakti Gala**, Assistant Professor, Central University of Gujarat, on Research Trends in LIS. She explicated the What, Which, When and Where and how of research. The current trends for research in Library and Information Science, the sources and websites to search for the dimensions of research in Library and Information Science. She also focused on the challenges occurs during conducting and publishing research.

The Next Talk was delivered by **Dr. Jignesh Amin**, Assistant Librarian, IIMA on Koha. He demonstrated the installation and implementation of Koha in Vikram Sarabhai Library, IIMA. He also focused on the challenges



faced during the migration to Koha as Library Management Software. The last talk of the day was delivered by **Dr. Kadam Mashruwala**, I/c Librarian, IIT Bombay on Best Practices at IIT Bombay Central Library. The talk was full of services delivered by the library to facilitate their users. Services like, Digital Wall, Special Section for Visually Impaired users, children section, language lab, kindle reader borrowing are the eye catching services.





discussed about the points system for valous activities which are considered in accreditation and ranking.


