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1. Introduction:

AICTE/MHRD had recommended a 3-week compulsory Induction Program for newly admitted U.G. students, in all technical colleges (in a phased manner) of the country. Since, the program has to be conducted by faculty members of the respective institutions, therefore a six days Faculty Development Program about student induction is highly required to be organised with following objectives to be inculcated in students' community:

- To improve bone health, cardio respiratory and muscular fitness and examine the effect of nutrition, rest and other lifestyle factors that contribute to the better health.
- To develop creativity and imagination through a range of complex activities and to improve the ability to control materials, tools and techniques.
- To impart universal human values and enable to live in harmony within surrounding, with family, with society and the nature. Also, initiate the process of self-exploration and self-investigation within themselves about their understanding of happiness.
- To inculcate the habit of active (or interactive) consumption of the best content available in literature, Develop thinking skills, Improve reading abilities and attitude.
- To introduce the student about innovation in different fields, Make students aware about innovative and modern practices and products in their own branch , Create awareness about support available for start-up and innovation

1.1 About Induction Program:

Newly introduced three weeks (90 hours) mandatory Induction Program for freshers of engineering was introduced from July-2018 by GTU with the recommendations of AICTE. This program contains largely: Physical activities, Creative Arts, Universal Human Values, Literary, Proficiency Modules, Lecture's by Eminent People, Visits to local Areas or Industry, Innovations etc.

1.2 Necessity of Faculty Development Program (FDP)

Keeping students engaged with the amalgamation of such content of induction program is a challenge for faculties as college/university professors are proficient in imparting hard-core engineering among the students. Going before the students with such design of content requires separate mental equipage, preparedness, readiness and confidence building. It is utmost necessity for a professor to understand spirit of newly introduced Induction Program and groom themselves to cultivate nurtured culture of healthy practices of Induction Program in the Institutions of higher technical studies.

Hence, the FDP was organised with the following expected outcome:

- To make faculties aware of the concept and details of the Induction Program, so that they can conduct the Human Values group discussions and do mentorship in their respective colleges.
- To clear the understanding on How to implement the content with right spirit in Induction Program.
- As the topics identified for the Induction Program are based on Self-Observation and are universal in nature (in the form of proposal). Faculty members are needed to learn these, through intensive interactive workshops conducted by resource persons.

1.3 Topics to be covered during FDP:

Topics of the FDP would be: Understanding value education, self exploration as the process of discovering values, basic human aspirations - continuous happiness and prosperity, understanding the harmony at four levels- self, family, society and nature, implications of this understanding for professional ethics in the light of right understanding and holistic technologies, production & management system.

1.4 Goal of FDP:

The whole workshop would be presented in the form of a dialogue/ proposal, whereby a set of proposals about various aspects of living would be presented and the participants will be encouraged to explore within themselves and verify these on the basis of their natural acceptance and experiential validation on their own right.

The focus is towards affecting a qualitative change in the consciousness of the participant, a change in the world-view rather than mere information transfer.





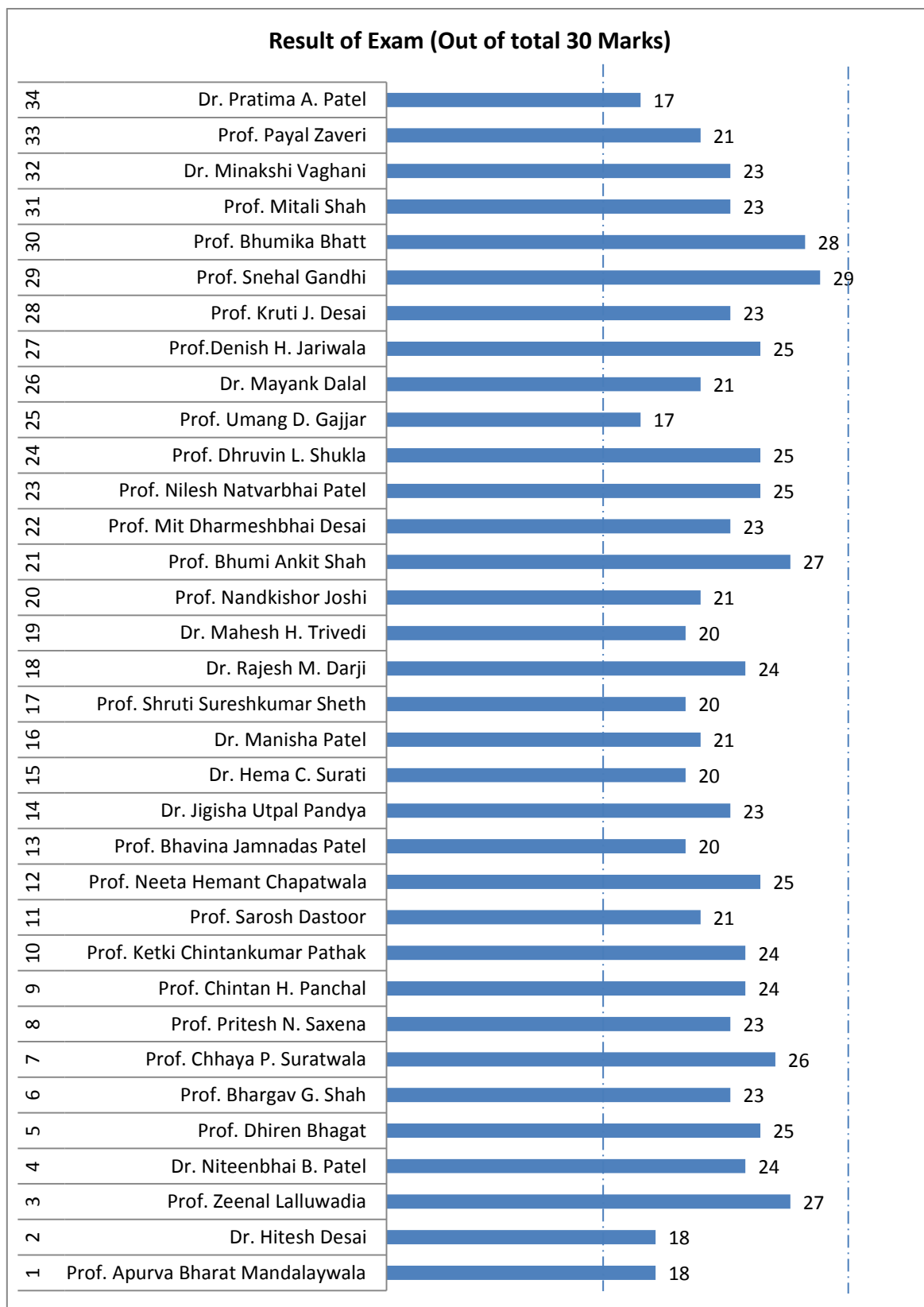
As most of the sessions were interactive sessions by proposing various thoughts on values, there were intense and active discussions on it. Every discussion was fruitful and correcting the miss-concepts of many. This type of notion have brought open minded, free, active and interactive environment in the FDP that have inspired many to follow during regular practice of imparting knowledge among the students in the class.

I strongly wish and recommend that such type of FDP be repeatedly and frequently conducted for the benefits of many of our needed staff-members.

In my opinion, we could give best infrastructure, course content, resource persons, presentations, interactive sessions, reading material and basic facilities to participants and their overall feedback also supports this fact.

9. Examination & Result:

A 30 marks MCQ exam was taken at the end of FDP. The questions were derived by resource persons and its answer key was also collected from them. The evaluation and assessment was done by the FDP coordinator. All the participant have crossed more than 50% marks (15 out of 30) in the test. Their individual marks are as follows:
